## LEVEL ONE

**PL111: Biblical Interpretation** Tuition: \$400  
eProf Steve Ganger Tuesdays, 7:30pm Eastern

Emphasizing the inductive approach to biblical interpretation, this course introduces students to methods of Bible study and to the principles of biblical interpretation. Students say, *“The assignments made me go beyond the surface”* and *“I really enjoyed this course!”* [Logos Bible software required for some assignments; however, auditors are not required to submit assignments.]

**PL271: Fundamentals of Christian Leadership** Tuition: \$400  
eProf Stan Buck Tuesdays, 8:00pm Eastern

This course explores the principles of Christian leadership that create the underpinnings of every successful local church. Students examine leadership principles from a biblical basis and learn to apply those principles to specific local church situations so that they become adept at exercising active leadership. One student said of this course, *“The textbook knowledge came alive by applying it to ministry. After every chat session, I was so pumped I wanted to go out (at 11:00pm) and change the world right on the spot!”*

## LEVEL TWO

**PL371: Missions & the Church** Tuition: \$400  
eProf Wayne Allen Thursdays, 7:30pm Eastern

God’s ultimate purpose in the world is to reveal His glory through the establishment of His Kingdom by the healing of the nations (Revelation 22:2), and the Church is the instrument of that healing. Come discover your role in God’s big-picture plan.

**PL611: Organic Discipleship Movements 1** Tuition: \$400  
eProf Don Snell Thursdays, 8:00pm Eastern

Defining disciple-making as “personal, intentional involvement, guided by the Holy Spirit, in helping individuals move from pre-Christian to a reproducing mature believer,” this course is tailor-made for those who want to make disciples who make disciples. Students will learn principles that are reproducible in any setting, any culture on earth, to launch disciple-making movements. A student reported, *“Before the quarter ended I was already using what I’d learned for Kingdom growth. The disciple-making principles we explored were more than just academic exercises.”* Though Part 1 of this two-part course focuses on the individual’s role, students won’t want to miss Part 2 (coming in the spring) to learn how to integrate new disciples into faith communities (local churches) for growth, nurturing, and service.

**xPL921: Wounded Heart (for women)** Tuition: \$300  
eProf Linda Oelze Mondays, 8:00pm EDT

**xPL922: Walking w/Wounded Heart (for men)** Tuition: \$300  
eProf John Oelze Tuesdays, 8:00pm

You may think you don’t know anyone who has been sexually abused, especially if your friends are Christians; but sexual abuse knows no religious or social boundaries. Wounded Heart, designed for women who have experienced childhood sexual abuse, helps participants find hope and healing in a study based on the book by the same title. Walking with the Wounded Heart, the companion course for husbands of women who were abused as a child, provides direction and hope for men committed to walking with their wives through this lifelong journey. an intensely personal look at this “soul deadening” offense.
